

**Village of Dorchester Board of Trustees Special Meeting  
April 22, 2021**

A Special Meeting of the Village of Dorchester Board of Trustees was held April 22, 2021 at 12:01 p.m. at the Dorchester Community Hall. Chairperson Andrea Pracheil advised those present of the Open Meeting Act. Answering Roll Call were board members Andrea Pracheil, Roger Miller, and Matt Scholz. Sarah Wenz and Kelly Vyhnalek were excused. Also in attendance were Gloria Riley, Clerk/Treasurer; and Jen Kasl, Deputy Clerk. (All motions carried are unanimous "for" unless otherwise noted). Advance notice of the meeting was posted at the Dorchester US Post Office, First State Bank, NE, and Village Hall.

The purpose of the meeting was consideration and discussion of Resolution 2021-04, to set or modify rates for surety bonds, cash deposits and liability coverage requirements from applicants for excavation permits. Pracheil presented Resolution 2021-04 for discussion.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-04**

**EXCAVATION PERMIT SURETY BOND, CASH DEPOSIT, AND LIABILITY  
INSURANCE RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF DORCHESTER, NEBRASKA, TO SET OR MODIFY RATES FOR SURETY BONDS, CASH DEPOSITS, AND LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE REQUIREMENTS FROM APPLICANTS FOR EXCAVATION PERMITS UNDER DORCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 6.

BE IT RESOLVED, that Chapter 8, Article 6 of the Revised Municipal Code of the Village of Dorchester, Nebraska, allows for the Village Board of the Village of Dorchester to set by resolution the surety bond amount, cash deposit, and minimum insurance coverage required from each applicant for an excavation permit. The Village Board sets the rates as follows:

- Surety Bond (Section 8-607): None required
- Cash Deposit (Section 8-608): \$500
- Liability Insurance (Section 8-640)
  - o The minimum acceptable limits of coverage are as follows:
    - Bodily and Property Damage: \$1,000,000 each occurrence, \$2,000,000 aggregate
    - Personal Injury Damage: \$1,000,000 each occurrence
    - Contractual Liability: \$1,000,000 each occurrence
    - Products Liability and Completed Operations: \$1,000,000 each occurrence
    - Automobile Liability: \$1,000,000 each occurrence
    - Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability: \$1,000,000 each occurrence
